


- *Pier Giorgio was actively involved with the Society of St. Vincent de Paul*

- *He joined at 17 and remained committed until the final hours of his life*



*Pier Giorgio did not shy away from expressing disagreement when he felt a Conference was straying from its mission. In a 1922 letter to his friend Carlo, he wrote, “If you want the truth, I’d actually do away with some of the Vincentian Conferences...” His frustration arose when one group decided to stop helping a family because of a member’s immoral behavior. Pier Giorgio argued that the family needed guidance, not rejection. Eventually, he left that Conference and joined another that aligned more closely with his convictions.*



## Meditation:

There are two kinds of courage: there's the courageous act: a firefighter rushing into a burning building. This is an extreme event most of us won't ever face. There's a second kind of courage: the decision to do the right thing even when it's unpopular, uncelebrated, or unnoticed. Where is the Lord calling you to be courageous? Even in the small things?

*In a passionate speech encouraging his fellow university students to get involved, he wrote: “I’m not sure how many of you truly understand what these institutions founded by St. Vincent de Paul are all about. They’re simple and ideal for students. The only requirement is to meet one day a week and visit two or three families. You’ll soon realize how much good we can do for others—and for ourselves.”*

- **struggling financially**
- **struggling with their faith**
- **trying to get up the courage to take a stand on some issue and sometimes alone**






