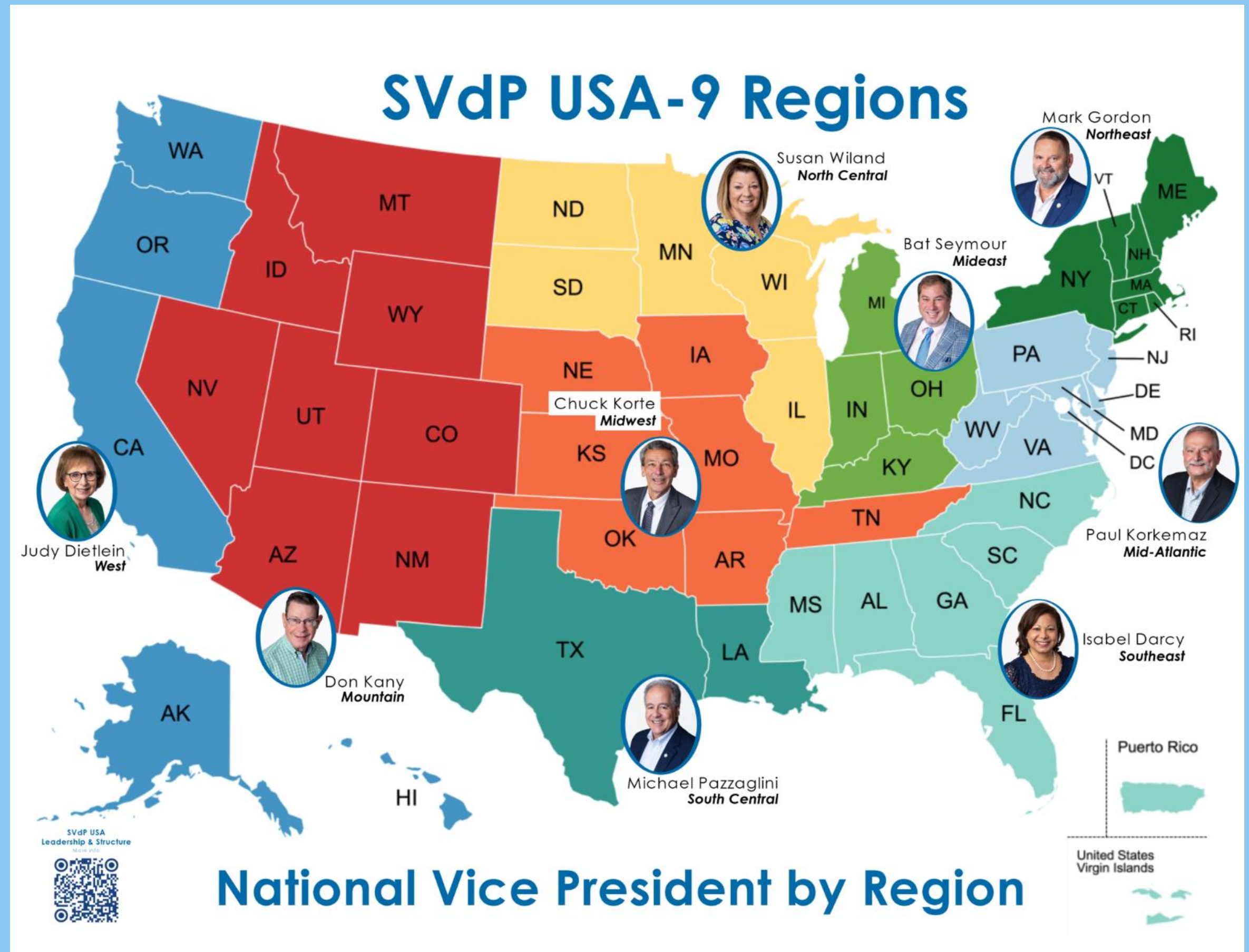

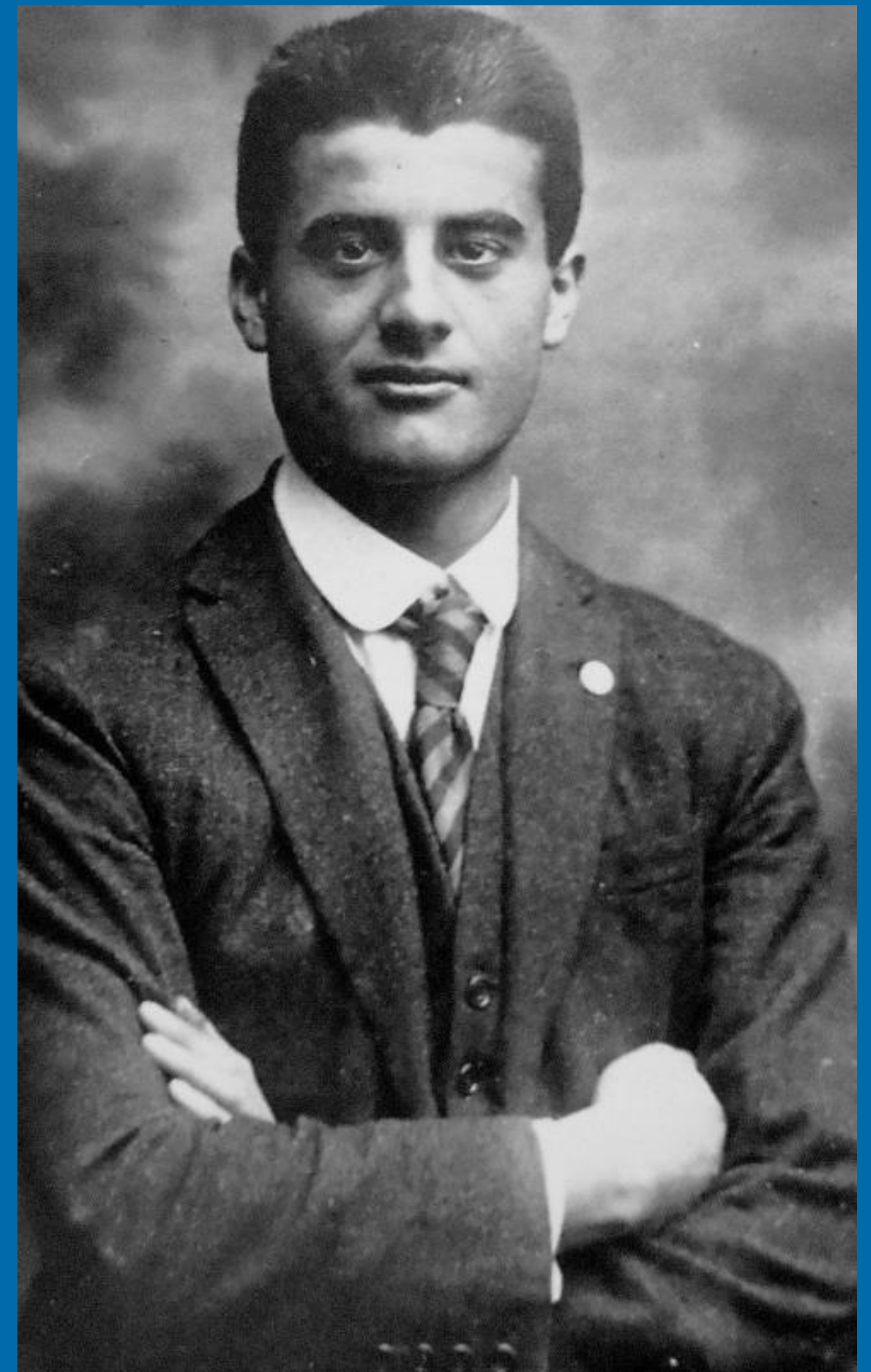

According to a source, **“People were stunned to see this young man pulling handcarts loaded with furniture for poor families trying to find housing. He entered the filthiest dwellings, giving away all the money he had, even if it meant walking home because he ran out of money for the bus.”**

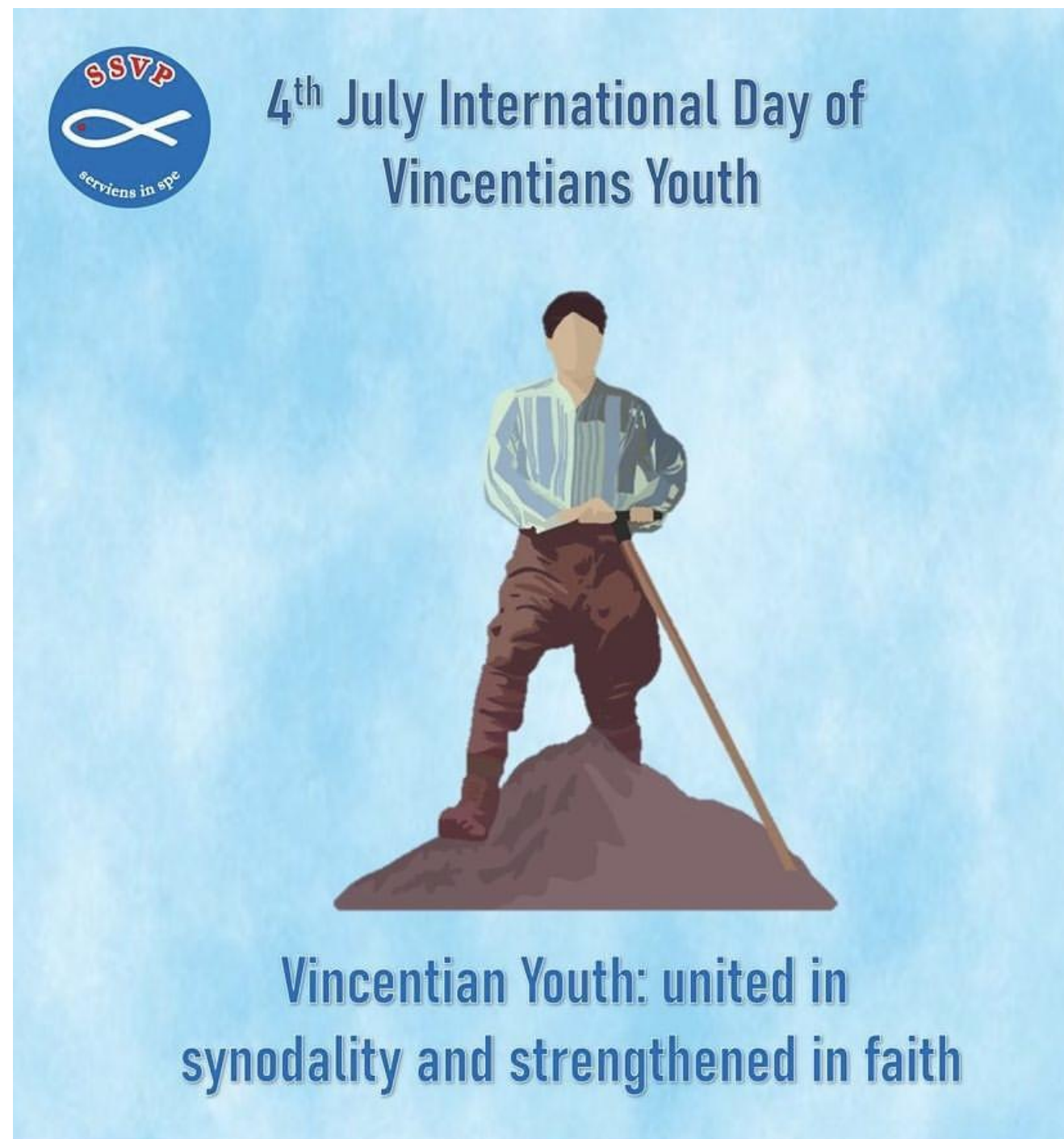


