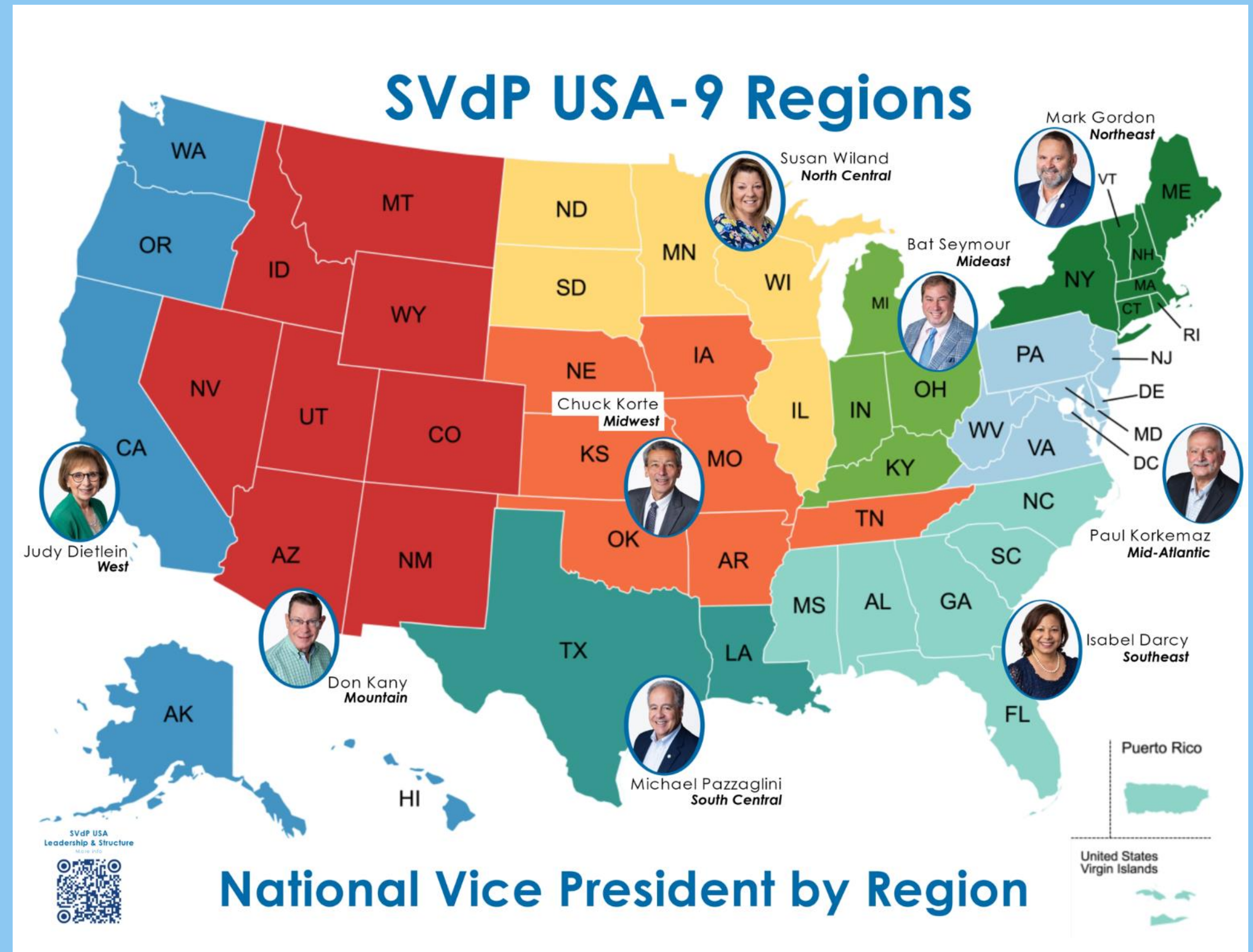

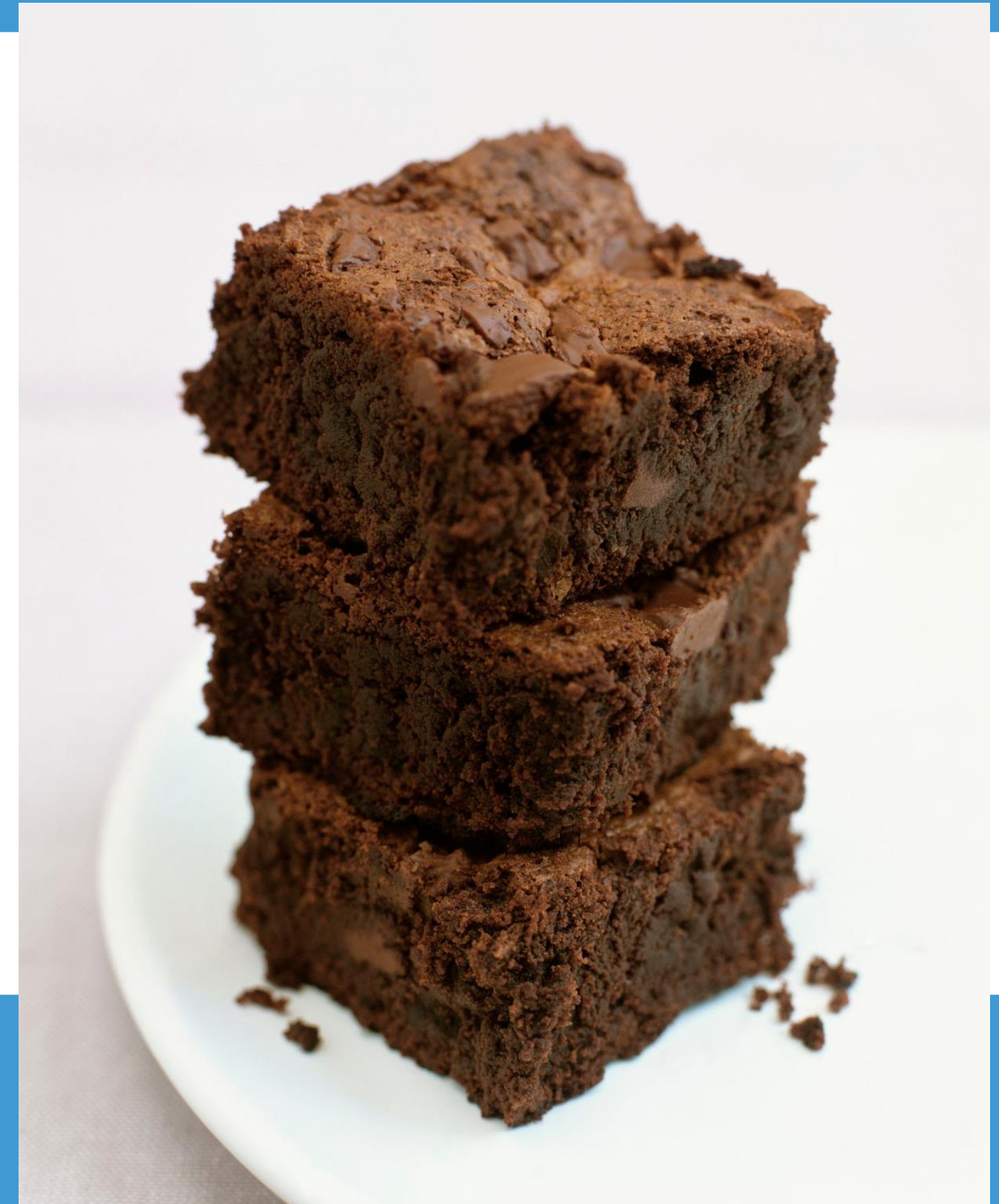

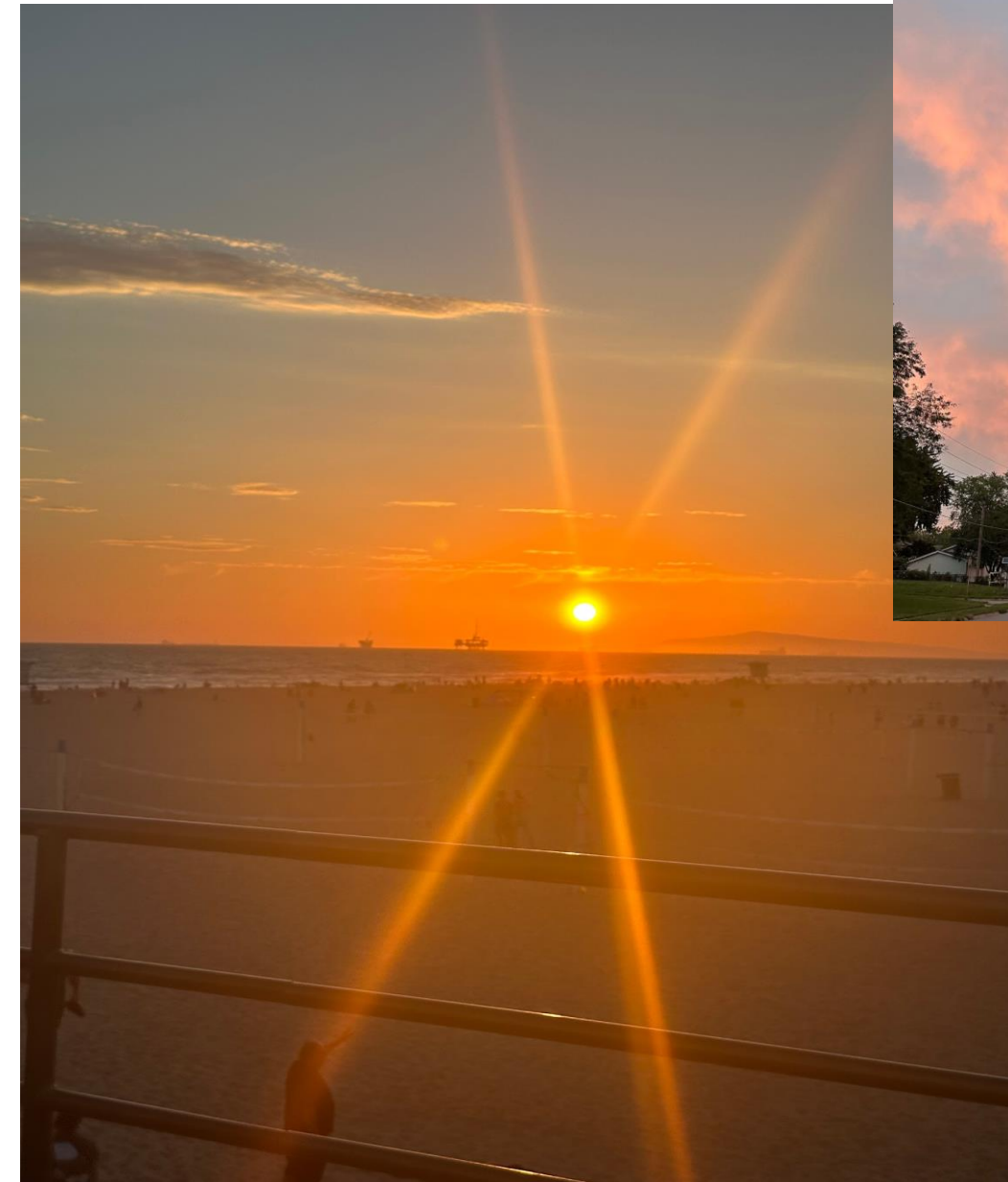

"Prayer is the noble supplication which we lift up to throne of God. It is the most efficient means to obtain from God the graces which we need."

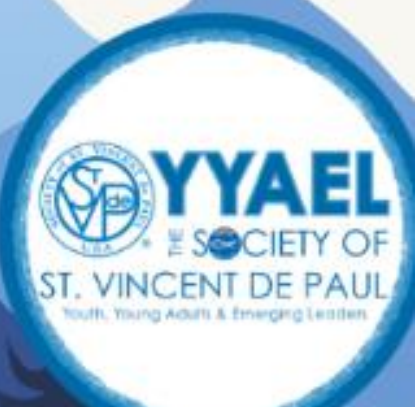

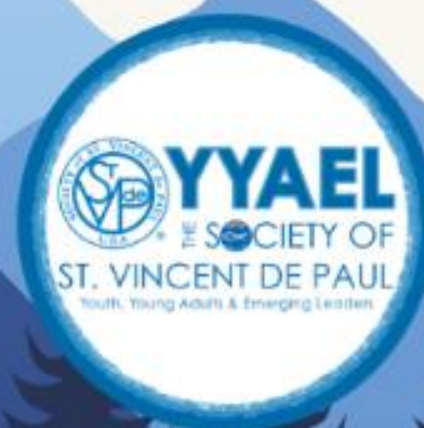
Meditation
